

CALLIA PINOT GRIGIO San Juan, Argentina

- 100% Pinot Grigio
- · Modern and innovative, Callia wines are youthful, wellcrafted, and managed by a winemaking team who are local to the region.
- Grapes are crushed and destemmed immediately

CALLIA CABERNET SAUVIGNON San Juan, Argentina

- 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Soils are composed primarily of rich sandy alluvial and clay loam; An elevation of 2,000ft asl helps to preserve acidity in the grapes
- These growing conditions contribute to the production of fruity, intense wines
- 30% of this blend was oak aged for three months, 50% in French and 50% in American Oak
- · Ripe fruit and spice aromas compliment a rounded, fruit-forward palate with noticeable but very mild tannins, making it delicate and easy to drink
- · Pair with red meat, pasta Bolognese or hard cheeses

- · 60% Syrah, 40% Malbec

- This winery's goal is to produce the best wines in San Juan, while respecting and supporting the people, nature, and community around them
- Grapes are crushed and destemmed immediately after harvest to preserve freshness and fruit character
- Delicate aromas of oranges & white flowers; Refreshing notes of citrus fruits, grapefruit and lemon on the palate
- Pairs well with grilled fish, sushi, pork chops, white pizzas and spicy Asian cuisine

CALLIA MALBEC

- 100% Malbec
- · Modern and innovative, Callia wines are youthful, wellcrafted, and managed by a winemaking team who are local to the region
- Hand-harvested grapes are immediately crushed and destemmed to preserve freshness and fruit character. 30% oak aged for three months (50% French & 50% American).
- The palate offers a balanced mouthfeel with flavors of redcurrant and black cherry supported by sweet, round tannins. It culminates in a long finish with notes of cloves and cinnamon
- Excellent with barbecued dishes, burgers, spicy Mexican food such as quesadillas or tacos, roasted pork, duck, and honey baked ham
