BACKGROUND

The Prüm family's roots in the Mosel region of Germany date back as far as 1156, making it one of the country's preeminent winemaking dynasties. Their incredible Riesling portfolio reflects traditional winemaking practices with exceptional single vineyard designated wines in every style. Family-owned S.A. Prüm, founded in 1911 by Sebastian Alois Prüm, was in the hands of Raimund Prüm, head winemaker and Sebastian's grandson, from 1971 to 2017. Under Raimund's leadership the property has earned a reputation as one of the most successful wineries in Germany's celebrated Mosel wine region. Today his daughter Saskia A. Prüm is taking care of the success of the family business.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

100% Riesling

TERROIR & VINTAGE NOTES

A selection of grapes from some of the top vineyard sites in Germany's Mosel region, grown only on steep hills.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are picked by hand in mid-October and de-stemmed before undergoing 12 hours of maceration on the skins. The juice is fermented with native yeasts for eight weeks in stainless steel tanks, it is aged sur lie for richness and character.

TASTING NOTES


Light gold in color. On the nose, exotic, intense fragrance recalling ripe apricot, citrus fruit, and petrol. Elegantly structured on the palate, with pronounced stone fruit and mineral character. A delicious match with chicken, seafood and Asian cuisine.
