

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON

VOLNAY, CLOS DE CHÊNES 1ER CRU 2013

BACKGROUND

Domaine Antonin Guyon is one of the most prestigious estates in the Côte d'Or, as well as one of the largest family-owned wineries in the region. It was started in the 1960s by Antonin Guyon with parcels of land in Gevrey and Meursault. Today, the massive 116 acre property is controlled and operated today by Antonin's sons, Dominique and Michel and produces wines of impeccable quality from 15 different appellations, which includes many renowned villages from the region. An exceptional range of Premier and Grands Crus.

APPELLATION

Volnay Clos de Chênes, France

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

100% Pinot Noir

WINEMAKING & VINTAGE NOTES

Volnay is located in the Côte de Beaune. Clos des Chênes is one of the most well known Premier Crus of the region located near the top of the Volnay Slope, facing due east. Soils here are predominantly limestone based and quite rocky. Grapes are hand-harvested and then carried in small boxes to the winery, where they are sorted. Fermentation takes place for 20 days in open wooden vats at a controlled temperature, with punching down.

AGING

Wine is aged in French oak barrels, 40% of which are new.

TASTING NOTES

Beautiful deep ruby in color. On the nose, the wine is full of aromas of small red fruits. Racy, with a nice length in the mouth, this wine has great richness. Keep for up to 10 years. Delicious with meat in rich sauces, roast duck and most cheeses.
