The 2014 Single Vineyard Block N.4 Malbec is from a plot on very stony, limestone and silex-rich soils at 1,400 meters in altitude... This was the first vineyard where they detected more complexity and concentration, and they later found that the vineyard has more limestone in the soil, with a fine texture that allows the roots to go down easily. This is showy and aromatic, quite distinct from the other wines. There is good fruit ... with oak-related flavors and some powdery tannins... – L.G.
