Their wines embrace a unique showcase range of Loire appellations; from its original home in Pouilly sur Loire to Sancerre, Chinon, Vouvray, Anjou & Muscadet forming an unprecedented collection across the Loire Valley.



"LA PERRIÈRE MÉGALITHE" SANCERRE Sancerre (Loire Valley), France

- · 100% Sauvignon Blanc
- Produced by the Saget family-awardwinning 9th generation Loire Valley producers
- Estate grown, hand harvested and estate bottled
- La Perrière caves were naturally carved 200m years ago, and age wines from the 106 acres of Saget estate Sancerre vineyards
- The grapes are hand-harvested from the 100% Silex soils
- 50% of the blend aged for 6 to 10 months in oak barrels
- · Certified HVE3
- · Well rounded with notes of ripe fruit and light vanilla, shows an astonishing fullness in the mouth

"LA PERRIÈRE" BLANC FUMÉ DE POUILLY Pouilly-Fumé (Loire Valley), France

- · 100% Sauvignon Blanc
- · Produced by the Saget family-awardwinning 9th generation Loire Valley producers
- Blanc Fumé de Pouilly is the original name of the appellation dating to 1937
- "Blanc Fumé" ("smoky white") refers to the thin smoke -colored layer covering the grapes at the time of harvest, and alludes to the struck gunflint aroma of the wines



- · Award-winning estate wine, not a negociant wine
- · Aged on fine lees for 6 months, then 6-8 months in cellar
- · After revealing mineral notes on the nose, the wine opens with a perfect balance of alcohol and acidity on the palate
