
# SONOMA COUNTY, UNITED STATES



Noble Tree was originally founded as a passion project by two sommeliers/restaurateurs to produce wines for their fellow industry friends. Production began as a true "garagistes-négociant" style winery, focusing on healthy vineyard sources, hand-harvesting and honest winemaking practices. Marc D. Taub, recognized the potential of these extraordinary Sonoma

County-based wines early on. In 2019, the Taub family became proprietors of Noble Tree, vowing to uphold the mission and essence of the winemaking philosophy: to respect the varietal character and reflect the vineyard site and vintage conditions in each wine.

- Noble Tree was originally founded in 2008 by two sommeliers/ restaurateurs as a true "garagistes-négociant" style winery, focusing on healthy vineyard sources, hand-harvesting and honest winemaking practices
- Originally founded by Thomas George Estates in 2008, the Taub Family took stewardship of the winery in 2019 and extended the family commitment to the wines of Sonoma County
- Noble Tree is a "by the glass" darling for sommeliers and was named
  "Value Brand of the Year" in 2017 by Wine Enthusiast
- All small production, estate fruit predominantly from Wickersham Ranch and Chalk Hill. Estate designation provides for total control of all facets of farming; each vineyard is fine-tuned for quality over quantity

#### **NOBLE TREE**

GRENACHE, SONS & DAUGHTERS RANCH, **CHALK HILL** 

Russian River Valley, CA, USA

- · 100% Grenache
- · This Grenache is from an Estate site in the middle reach of the Russian River Valley with rocky, sandy loam soils
- Aged for ten months in 63% neutral oak barrels and 37% concrete egg tanks
- Notes of ripe raspberry, strawberry and white pepper
- · Aromatic, palate is rich with warm woodsy red fruit flavors with nice spice and balanced acidity




#### **NOBLE TREE**

NOBLE BLANC, CHALK HILL

Russian River Valley, CA, USA

- · 75% Grenache Blanc, 25% Viognier
- · Sourced entirely from the Chalk Hill Ranch Estate, from grapes grown on vines planted in the mid 1970's



Notes of subtle stone fruit and ripe citrus; The crisp mouth feel shows great classic Rhone-varietal viscosity

#### **NOBLE TREE**

PINOT NOIR, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Russian River Valley, CA, USA

- · 100% Pinot Noir
- · A very clean iteration of a classic Russian River Valley Pinot Noir
- This wine is aged for 10 months in neutral French oak
- · The nose offers bright un-ripened raspberry, rose, and a hint of stone-ground cinnamon
- · The luscious palate displays strawberry, pomegranate, and violet; finishes with a hint of vanilla, subtle tannin with a bright and satisfying acidity

# WICKERSHAM RANCH ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Sonoma County, CA, USA

- · 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- A beautiful, classic cool-climate, mountain-grown 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- Sourced entirely from the Wickersham Ranch Estate located at 2,200' elevation in Sonoma Co.
- Aged ten months (40% French oak, 60% stainless steel)
- Aromas of lead pencil, and spiced red fruits; Flavors of currant, blackberry, black pepper with a chalky texture; Finishes with notes of white pepper and cranberry with well-defined tannins

### WICKERSHAM RANCH ESTATE MERLOT

Sonoma County, CA, USA

WINE & SPIRITS

- · 100% Merlot
- · Sourced entirely from the Wickersham Ranch Estate located at 2,200 ft elevation in Sonoma Co.
- The Vineyard is one of the most remote sites in all of Sonoma County and offers the ideal microclimate to grow grapes for the production of mountain Merlot of the highest quality
- · Aged 16 months in French oak (40% new)
- · Aromas of lead pencil, and spiced red fruits: Flavors of blackberry, black pepper with an almost spicy texture; Finishes with well-defined chalky tannins
