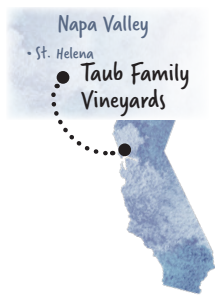




TAUB FAMILY VINEYARDS

NAPA VALLEY, UNITED STATES



Taub Family Vineyards was born out of a dream four generations in the making. Marty Taub played an instrumental role in the wine business from the early 1930s, and his son David built upon his dream. Marc D. Taub, the third generation, grew up with a deep appreciation for the art of winemaking and had a vision of one day making his own wines.

This came to fruition in 2013, when Marc, who today works side by side with son Jake, acquired Napa Valley producer Heritance – which later evolved to Taub Family Vineyards. The winery produces elegant, pure expressions of its respective AVAs and vineyard microsites, focusing exclusively on mid-valley sites in Rutherford, Oakville, Mount Veeder, and Howell Mountain with limited-release single vineyard wines.

- The name Heritance is derived from Heritance & Inheritance, with the valley oak on the label representing the Taub family's roots in California and the diamond "seed" planted for future generations.
- With the 2015 Cabernets and 2017 Sauv Blanc, the Heritance evolved into Taub Family Vineyards symbolizing the strength of the family's commitment, dedication and connection to Napa Valley.
- The winery produces elegant, pure expressions of its respective mid-valley and mountain AVAs and vineyard microsites including those of the Beckstoffer & Morisoli families.
- Taub Family Vineyards is a proud member of Napa Valley Vintners Association and the Rutherford Dust Society contributing to the development, promotion and sustainability of the region.

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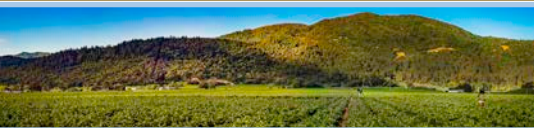

BECKSTOFFER VINEYARD GEORGES III
CABERNET SAUVIGNON, RUTHERFORD
Napa Valley (Rutherford), USA

- 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- The grapes are from a four acre block within the Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III; The soils are bale, clay loam with gravel. The vines are 25 years on average
- Each bottle is individually numbered
- 24 months ageing, in 100% new French Oak
- This vineyard and clonal selection imparts opulence, intensity, structure, complexity; This is considered the king of Cabernets.

TAUB FAMILY VINEYARDS

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, RUTHERFORD
Napa Valley (Rutherford), USA

- 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
- The grapes are grown on the benches and foothill vineyards in Rutherford AVA. The deep and well-drained soils are primarily gravel, sand, and loam.
- The vines are clone 337, 6, 7, & 8 with rootstocks 5C and O39-16; 20-25 years old on average
- Aged 20 months in 75% new French oak
- Polished and alluring palate full of plum, dark maraschino cherry, roasted coffee bean, tobacco leaf, bergamot tea and subtle vanillin braced by a backbone of supple, dusty tannins
- Rutherford soil-tinged minerality

"HERITANCE" CABERNET SAUVIGNON,
NAPA VALLEY
Napa Valley, USA

- 94% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Merlot, 2% Petit Verdot
- The grapes are from mid-valley, core growing sites:
 - Oakville: Bale clay loams. Clones 4,7,337,2. 18 year-old vines; Provides powerful tannins
 - St Helena: Pleasanton gravelly loams. Clone 7, 8, 337. 18 year-old vines average; Provides elegance
 - Rutherford: Bale clay loams. Clones 4, 7, 337, 2. Average 18 year-old vines; Provides opulence
 - Howell Mtn: Pyroclastic, volcanic soils. 15 years old on average; Provides focused fruit from lower yields
 - Mt Veeder: Sedimentary soils, with 25 year-old vines; Provides refined tannins
- Aged for 18 months in 100% French Oak (60% new)
- Ripe dark fruit such as cherries and blackberries; Oak is well integrated with baking spice and subtle cedar notes

TAUB FAMILY VINEYARDS

"HERITANCE" SAUVIGNON BLANC,
NAPA VALLEY
Napa Valley, USA

- 92% Sauvignon Blanc, 8% Semillon
- Comes from the Pestoni vineyard in Rutherford; Vines are an average of 20 years old, planted on alluvium-gravel, Rutherford bench soils
- The vineyard is planted with Clone 317 (lean acidity clone for structure) with some Sauvignon Blanc Musque (an aromatic clone)
- Tropical fruit driven and stainless steel fermented; The 8% Semillon is in neutral oak for four months which gives it complexity and richness
- Tropical fruit, citrus, and pineapple with floral hints; The palate shows nuances of melon, pear and citrus with a firm acidity and a smooth lingering finish
