INTEGRITY

The Taub family’s roots in the California wine business date back to the days just following the end of Prohibition. **Three generations** of Taubs, starting with Martin Taub, have contributed to an illustrious and enterprising legacy in the wine and spirits trade. Inspired by his family’s legacy, **Taub Family Vineyards was released in 2013** by Marc D. Taub when he acquired the Heritance winery.

FAMILY

The **valley oak** that appears on the Taub Family Vineyards – Heritance labels **represents the family’s roots** and ties to California wines.

The **diamond** at the base of the tree symbolizes the seed that is planted for **future generations**.

CURIOSITY

Industry veteran and lead winemaker Tom Hinde ensures Taub Family Vineyards has access to the **best grapes throughout the valley** with long term relationships and continues to expand the winery’s offerings with **single vineyard wines such as Morisoli Borges and Missouri-Hopper**.

TERROIR

Heritance-Taub Family Vineyards has been **focusing on mid-valley** growing sites with Cabernet Sauvignon from Rutherford. Its recent expansion to **Howell Mountain, Oakville & Mt Veeder** emphasizes its mission of offering prestige wines representative of the best the valley offers.

"Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III" Cabernet Sauvignon, Rutherford

DID YOU KNOW?

The **Beckstoffer Georges III** Vineyard lies within the Rutherford AVA in Napa Valley. A portion of this vineyard was planted in 1895 by Mrs. Thomas Rutherford. This parcel was purchased by Beaulieu founder Georges de Latour in 1928 and called Beaulieu Vineyard No. 3. Purchased by Beckstoffer Vineyards in 1988, the vineyard has since been replanted using new Cabernet Sauvignon clones, with tighter spacing and advanced trellising systems, further enhancing quality. In 2009, Beckstoffer Georges III was placed under a land conservation easement that forever prohibits non-agricultural development. Taub Family Vineyards gets its own dedicated 4 acre block from this vineyard and has a long term farming agreement working step by step with the Beckstoffers. Not only is there a farming relationship but both names are on the label!

GRAPE VARIETY //
100% Cabernet Sauvignon

STYLE //
Opulence, intensity, structure, complexity. Aromas of black cherry, vanilla, sage, blueberry, and roasted notes. The wine approaches with silky, refined tannins and firm structure. Flavors of dark fruit layers evolve over a harmonious, balanced seamless palate. Malolactic fermentation in barrel, with total 24 months aging, in 100% new French Oak (Allier & Tronçais). Each bottle is individually numbered.



APPELLATION //

Rutherford. The grapes are from the Beckstoffer Vineyard Georges III, from a 4 acre block on bale, clay loam with gravel soils. The vines are 22 years on average, with Clonal Selection of 4, 337 and 7.

ABOUT THE WINERY //

Taub Family Vineyards was born out of a dream four generations in the making. Marty Taub played an instrumental role in the wine business from the early 1930s, and his son David built upon his dream. Marc D. Taub, the third generation, grew up with a deep appreciation for the art of winemaking and had a vision of one day making his own wines. This came to fruition in 2013, when Marc, who today works side by side with son Jake, acquired Napa Valley producer Heritage – which later evolved to Taub Family Vineyards. The winery produces elegant, pure expressions of its respective AVAs and vineyard microsites.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Rutherford

DID YOU KNOW?

Rutherford is one of the most famous and prestigious areas in Napa Valley. It is named after Thomas Lewis Rutherford, who married Elizabeth Yount, granddaughter of Napa's pioneering vignerons George C. Yount.

Cabernet Sauvignon is the most widely planted grape here. The long, warm summer days encourage the organic, earthy flavors for which Napa Cab has become known, complemented by opulent fruit richness.

ABOUT THE WINERY //
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APPELLATION //

The grapes are grown on the benches and foothill vineyards in Rutherford AVA. The deep and well-drained soils are primarily gravel, sand, and loam. The vineyards include Morisoli (10 acres with vine age avg of 20 years), Slaughterhouse (4 acres with vine age avg 15 years), and Beckstoffer (4 acres with vine age average of 22 years).

STYLE //

On the nose, intense and brooding aromas with hints of black currant, plum, cedar, dust, and roasted coffee. A complex midpalate and weighty mouthfeel with vanilla and evolved spice notes. Balanced and refined tannins lead to a lingering finish. Malolactic fermentation in barrel, with total 20 months aging, in 75% new French Oak (Allier & Tronçais).

Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

DID YOU KNOW?

This is made in a Bordeaux style blend. The mid valley growing sites which have warm, sunny climate is well suited to the Bordeaux grapes.

This tradition has been upheld since the original founder of Heritance, Bernard Portet was from France.

The TFV Heritance Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon has perfectly balanced tannins, fruit and oak with a new world style yet retains the elegance of a Bordeaux blend.

GRAPE VARIETIES //

94% Cabernet Sauvignon
4% Merlot
2% Petit Verdot

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APPELLATION //

NAPA VALLEY. The grapes are grown in mid-valley locations:
Yountville (5 acres of alluvial soils with 20 year old vines, imparts soft tannins)
Oakville (11 acres of bale clay loam, 15 year old vines imparts powerful tannins)
Rutherford (30 acres of bale clay loam, 24 year old vines imparts elegance)
St Helena (8 acres of Pleaston gravelly loams, 15 year old vines, imparts opulence)

STYLE //

On the nose, intense and brooding aromas with hints of black currant, plum, cedar, dust, and roasted coffee.

A complex midpalate and weighty mouthfeel with vanilla and evolved spice notes. Balanced and refined tannins lead to a lingering finish. Malolactic fermentation in barrel, with total 20 months aging, in 75% new French Oak.

TAUB FAMILY VINEYARDS - HERITANCE

Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley

DID YOU KNOW?

This is a “Bordeaux style” blend due to the addition of the Semillon in the blend. This tradition has been upheld since the original founder of Heritance, Bernard Portet was from France and styled his wines after the some of the best wines in France. While “Bordeaux blend” is neither a legal or technical terms it relates to vinification regimen, which evokes a style of more creaminess and complexity with some oak aging.

GRAPE VARIETIES //

92% Sauvignon Blanc
8% Semillon

STYLE //

Pale lemon-green color. On the nose, tropical fruit, Meyer lemon, and pineapple, with hints of orange blossom. The palate shows nuances of melon and Asian pear which gives way to good acidity and crispness, followed by a smooth lingering finish.

95% stainless steel fermented. The wine was kept on their lees to soften the relatively high acidity and impart some creamy complexity. The remaining 5% was barrel fermented and aged sur lies before blending into the larger lot for added complexity.



APPELLATION //

Napa Valley

This Sauvignon Blanc comes from vineyards in the Oakville cross (10 acres on bale clay loam averaging 12 years old). The Semillon comes from the St. Helena AVA, grown in soil of well drained gravel and alluvial-loam with the vines age of 10 years.

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
