



# CHÂTEAU BELLEVUE

## BORDEAUX BLANC 2019

### BACKGROUND

Château Bellevue is located on an over 200 acre vineyard and produces a range of Bordeaux whites and reds. The château is located on a large hill, overlooking the vineyards, and is locally nicknamed the “Tuscany of Bordeaux.” Winemaker, Daniel Sore, utilizes the art of modern wine-making to produce Bordeaux wines that are characteristic of the local terroir.

### APPELLATION

Bordeaux (Bordeaux Blanc), France

### VARIETAL COMPOSITION

50% Sauvignon, 45.5% Sémillon, 3 % Colombard, 1% Muscadelle, 0.5% Merlot Blanc

### WINEMAKING & VINTAGE NOTES

The wines of Bellevue benefit from the latest techniques of vinification and are harvested when grapes and seeds come to perfect maturity. Destemming and crushing of the grapes, pneumatic pressing, skin maceration for the Sauvignons, “débouillage,” cold stabilization for four days, temperature-controlled fermentation for eight to 10 days.

### AGEING

Aged four to six months on fine lees in stainless steel tanks.

### TASTING NOTES

Brilliant light yellow color. Notes of ripe fruit, peach, exotic fruits and pink grapefruit on the nose. The mouth is aromatic and fleshy with sweetness and great freshness.
