Full-bodied and very juicy with a spectrum of flavors that build on the palate. Very tight, grippy tannin coats the mouth. Powerful... Long and ambitious. Drink or hold. – J.S.

OCTOBER 2020

A Malbec from a special lot in the Pedernal Valley, half aged for 12 months in French and American barrels. Purple with a terracotta meniscus. The nose offers pencil box, dark fruit and olives plus thyme and chocolate notes. Juicy and chalky in the mouth, with good concentration; the freshness keeps it light on its feet... conveying a clear high-altitude character.. -J.H.

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POINTS

Decanter

MAY 2020

Located at 1,400m in the province of San Juan, the Pedernal Valley has become an exciting terroir to explore. The vines grow in a mild, sunny climate in flinty limestone soils, resulting in wines like this, which combines herbal aromas with earthy, mineral flavours, cassis and cherries. Dense in the mouth, it offers excellent freshness and a chalky texture.
