This single-vineyard wine has a structure that shows in the ripe tannins. It comes from a southeast-facing slope close to the 17th century castle. Richly textured and with ripe black fruits, the wine will be ready to drink from late 2020. —R.V.

Attractive aromas of berry fruits and forest floor preface the 2017 Brouilly Vieilles Vignes from the Château de La Chaize, a medium to full-bodied, layered and velvety wine with good depth and concentration, lively acids and fine structuring tannins. - W.K.

...The fruit ferments spontaneously in a traditional Burgundy style, then the wine ages in foudres. It presents a dark and fragrant Brouilly with substantial tannins... Above those tannins, the wine is bright and juicy, with lively freshness that will last. —J.G.
