This is a super fragrant and gently flinty style with great definition of aromas, flavors and structure. The palate has a very fresh, very juicy feel, delivering an array of bright raspberries. Drink now. – J.S.

POINTS WINE ENTHUSIAST MARCH 2019

This vineyard lies on the steep southern slope of Mont Brouilly, which gives the vines plenty of sun, hence its name "scorching place." The wine certainly is warm, with rich tannins and intense, juicy red-cherry fruits. Its structure and concentration will allow the wine to age, so drink from 2020. – R.V.

POINTS Wine Spirits **APRIL 2020**

...The amaro-like bitterness of the wine's tannins adds tension, echoing the vineyard's altitude and spare soil. The fruit fills that structure with generosity and freshness, yielding a floral fragrance as it opens with air. Tightly built, this needs bottle age to mellow. - T.T.
