This red delivers an impressive rush of steeped blueberry and black cherry compote flavors, lined with subtle bay leaf, warm earth and sweet tapenade notes. There's a floral hint to add lift on the finish, along with ample grip for the cellar. Best from 2023 through 2036. — J.M.

Summer-like scents of crushed stone, dusty roads, dried herbs and wild blackberries appear on the nose of the 2018 Cornas la Louvee... Medium to full-bodied, it's supple and ripe, smooth and easy to drink, with a long, silky finish that adds savory hints of beef and anise. - J.C.
