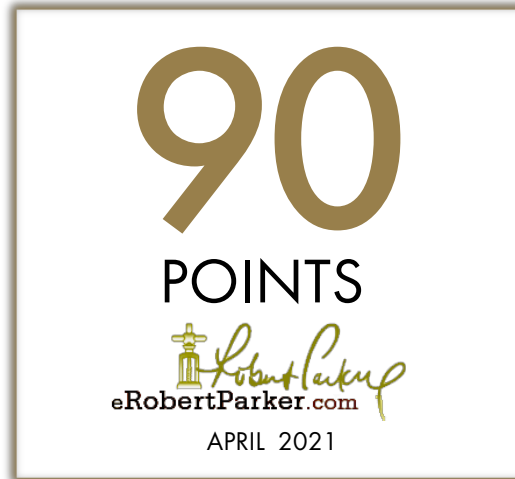


DOMAINE DE L'A

CASTILLON CÔTES DE BORDEAUX 2018

Bordeaux, France



...Leaps from the glass with bold scents of crushed redcurrants, plum preserves and mulberries, plus hints of graphite, tobacco leaf and cedar chest with a waft of dried mint. The elegantly styled, medium-bodied palate features bright, crunchy red and black fruits with a firm texture of ripe, grainy tannins and bags of freshness, finishing long with a skip in its step. – L.P.B.



The 2018 Domaine de l'A is blossoming nicely in bottle. The nose features a mixture of red and black fruit laced with light vanilla and cedar aromas, well defined and not too imposing. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit, fine tannins and very well-judged acidity... Give it two or three years ... it will gain some length. – N.M.
