Aromas of blackcurrants, violets, crushed gravel, tobacco and cocoa butter. Some toffee on the palate. It's medium-to full-bodied with firm, velvety tannins. Polished and creamy with a solid core of ripe fruit and spice. Drink or hold. - J.S.

... 70% of the wine matured in second and third use bariques for 12 months while the rest was kept unoaked. The wine feels very integrated—the different varieties and also the oak with the fruit. It has very nice balance and harmony and really represents the place, warm and stony, with a special elegance. – L.G.
