Produced with fruit from Vista Flores... fermented in stainless steel, with 70% of the volume put through malolactic, and it aged in second and third use 225-liter French oak barrels for 12 months. It's varietal, floral, clean and expressive, open and showy. It has a juicy palate with round, glossy tannins and very integrated oak (it's very fruit-driven and peachy) and is nicely balanced. – L.G.
