Ripe and showy in feel, with lots of warmed fig, blackberry and plum compote aromas and flavors, supported by velvety tannins and backed by a long, ganache- and incense-filled finish. Very seductive. Merlot and Cabernet Franc. Best from 2021 through 2037.— J.M.

**POINTS** WINEENTHUSIAST APRIL 2018

[92-94. Barrel Sample]. This is dense, rich and full of fruits and spice. It is a powerful wine, with concentrated tannins behind the smooth exterior. The finish shows freshness thanks to a flourish of acidity. – R.V.

**POINTS** eRobertParker.com MARCH 2020

...Unfurling to reveal notes of crushed rocks, iron ore and wild mushrooms over a core of blackberry pie, wild blueberries and mulberries. Mediumbodied, the palate delivers mineraltinged black fruits and a firm, chewy frame, finishing earthy. - L.P.B

**POINTS Decanter** FEBRUARY 2020

Bright with softly-spoken raspberry and autumnal berry fruits alongside touches of grilled almonds. There's a sweetness to the fruits that creeps in halfway through and gives an extra cushion of flesh... this has charm, it is well made, has been expertly aged over the past 18 months and has soft tannins with well brushed Pomerol character... – J.A.
