

## **DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON** LA JUSTICE GEVREY - GEVREY CHAMBERTIN 2019

## Burgundy, France



Mint and tobacco aromas give way to black currant and blackberry fruit in this ripe red. This turns more supple with air, getting support from moderate tannins. The balance renders this approachable with decanting, but better to wait a few years. Fine length. Best from 2023 through 2035. –B.S. This full-bodied red offers juicy blackberry and boysenberry flavors accented by hints of bramble and scorched earth. Sourced from La Justice, a vineyard located just below the village of Gevrey, this mouthwatering, fruit-focused Pinot is matured 18 months in French oak barrels (one-third new). Silky and soft in tannin... -A.I. ...A medium to full-bodied, supple and sensual red that bursts from the glass with aromas of peonies, blackberries, spices and sweet soil tones. Built around melting tannins and lively acids, it's drinking well out of the gates. – W.K.
