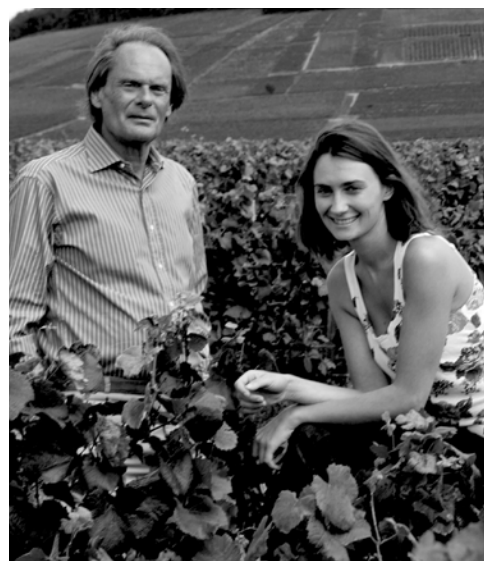
BURGUNDY, FRANCE



When Antonin Guyon started out in the 1960s, he had but a few small parcels of land in Gevrey and Meursault—not an uncommon footing to have in the fragmented tapestry of Burgundy. But today, thanks in part to his forward-thinking sons Dominique and Michel, the domaine has evolved into one of the most prestigious in the Côte d’Or, with day-to-day operations helmed by Dominique and his daughter, Hombeline.

Based in Savigny-lès-Beaune, the family’s vineyard properties stretch around the hill of Corton, north to Gevrey, south to Meursault, west to the Hautes Côtes de Nuits and east to Chorey-lès-Beaune. Their wines, including an exceptional range of Premier and Grands Crus, represent 15 different appellations, including many renowned cru villages, giving Domaine Antonin Guyon the depth of a traditional négociant, with estate-produced wines that represent a variety of quality tiers and price points.

- In the mid 1980’s Dominique Guyon took over as the second generation of the family to manage this esteemed Burgundy house. Hombeline Guyon, the third generation, studied enology in Dijon and since 2015 has assisted her father with winery activities and representation.
- The biggest single addition to the family’s holdings came after Dominique had accumulated hundreds of small parcels from almost 80 different Hautes Côtes de Nuits growers in Meuilley into a single, 20-hectare block of south-facing vines.
- Quality stands apart on all Domaine Guyon wines. Harvest is done 100% by hand with the first triage selection at the vine; the aim is to get the grapes to the cuverie within 30 minutes of picking. A second triage is done on the sorting table before the red grapes are completely destemmed then placed in large open-top wooden fermentation tanks.
- Dedicated to the utmost standards at every step, the vineyard team carefully selects and hand harvest the grapes before gently laying them in small wooden boxes (les caisses), at which point they are hurried back to the winery for a secondary sort, manual destemming, and finally vinification.

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON CHARMES-CHAMBERTIN GRAND CRU

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- The Charmes Chambertin is the smallest climat owned by Domaine Antonin Guyon; it produces no more than 500 bottles per harvest
- The vineyards are among the most famous of the eight Grand Crus of Gevrey Chambertin, covering 8.65 acres of soil that is primarily limestone and clay
- Grapes are hand-harvested and then carried in small wooden boxes to the cellars where they are sorted
- The wine is aged in French oak barrels (40% new) for 16 months
- Aromas of cranberry and raspberry, this is a powerful and elegant wine; Complex and intense, it can be kept for more than 10 years

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON CORTON CLOS DU ROY GRAND CRU

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- Corton is the only red Grand Cru in the Cote de Beaune. The Clos du Roy parcel is located near the top of the Corton hill facing due east. The soils here are clay and limestone
- Due to both its soil composition of limestone and exposition facing due east, Clos du Roy tends to be the most structured of all the various climats of Corton
- * Only about five barrels produced per harvest.
- Very rich, concentrated and harmonious in the mouth. Elegant and pure, with very fine tannins and beautiful structure, this wine can be kept for up to 20 years

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON CORTON-BRESSANDES GRAND CRU

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- Corton Bressandes wines are made under the Corton Grand Cru appellation in the Cote de Beaune district of Burgundy
- Grapes are hand harvested then carried in small boxes and for sorting at the winery
- Long fermentation during 20 days in wooden open vats with punching down of the cap and temperature control
- Ageing in oak barrels (50% new oak) and estate bottling after 18 months
- Very rich, with delicate expression of dark berry fruits; Pure and elegant with very fine tannins and a beautiful structure

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON ALOXE-CORTON, LES FOURNIÈRES 1ER CRU

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- Alox-Corton is a little village located at the foothills of the Corton hillside, in the northern part of the Côte de Beaune
- The wines here benefit from east to south and southwest exposure; Soils are predominantly clay and limestone
- Fournières is named for an ancient forge, whose large chimney near the village is still visible
- The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels, one-third of which are new barrels
- Rich and round in the mouth, with a long finish and a well-balanced woody character; Can be kept for 15 years

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON VOLNAY, CLOS DE CHÊNES 1ER CRU

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- Volnay is a village in the Côte de Beaune sub-region of Burgundy, renowned for making some of the smoothest, most delicate Pinot Noir wines of the southern Côte d'Or
- Clos des Chênes is a famous Volnay vineyard that monks had enclosed by a wall ("Clos"); "Chênes" means Oak and refers to the proximity of an old oak forest at the time
- The wine is aged in French oak barrels, 40% of which are new
- Aromas of small red fruits; Racy, with a nice length in the mouth, this wine has great richness; Keep for up to 10 years

DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON BEAUNE "CLOS DE LA CHAUME GAUFRIOT" MONOPOLE

Burgundy, France

- 100% Pinot Noir
- This 1.9 acre monopole vineyard is located in the villages' vineyards west of the town of Beaune, which is the epicenter of Burgundy's wine trade and the second largest town in the Côte d'Or wine region
- Surrounded by ancient walls built by Cistercian Monks, the soils here are predominantly limestone and clay
- The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels, (25% new)
- Delicate aromas and a silky texture; Elegant and well-balanced with finesse, this wine can be kept for five to eight years



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DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN LA JUSTICE *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Pinot Noir
- La Justice vineyard site sits just below the village of Gevrey and is considered the best lieu-dit in Gevrey-Chambertin
- Gevrey-Chambertin – a village in Burgundy's Côte de Nuits district – is home to nine grand cru vineyards, more than any other Burgundy village
- The soils here are primarily clay and limestone based, with significant mineral deposits
- Grapes are hand-harvested then carried in small wooden boxes to the cellars, where they are sorted
- The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels (1/3 new barrels)
- Widely regarded as being Burgundy's most full-bodied and structured, this wine is very round and well-balanced, with subtle woody tannins and a silky texture; Can be kept for 10 years



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY LES CRAS *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Pinot Noir
- The village vineyard site sits just below the 1er Cru of the same name; Superbly situated, the soils are a mix of iron rich clay and limestone rock
- "Les Cras" means small calcareous pebbles, which are found in the vineyard
- The climate in Chambolle-Musigny – as throughout the wider Côte d'Or – is of continental type; Seasonal and diurnal (day-night) temperature variation helps to establish balanced acids and sugars in the wines
- The wine is aged for 18 months in French oak barrels (25% new)
- Elegant and stylish, Chambolle-Musigny is known for its deep intense red and black fruits with a subtle power in depth and finish; It ages well and can be kept for 10 years and structured, this wine is very round and well-balanced, with subtle woody tannins and a silky texture; Can be kept for 10 years



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON SAVIGNY-LES-BEAUNE LES GOUDELETTES *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Pinot Noir
- Located just northwest of Beaune, Savigny-Les Beaune represents extraordinary value in Burgundy
- Les Goudelettes lieu-dit is located at the bottom of the Corton hillside and benefits from an exceptional soil composition the likes of its illustrious adjacent Grands Crus of Corton; The soils here are predominantly clay and limestone based
- Goudelettes means "golden drops"
- Ageing in oak barrels (15% new oak) and estate bottling after 15 months
- Elegant, well balanced with very fine tannins; This wine can be kept for 8–10 years



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON HAUTES CÔTES DE NUITS ROUGE "LES DAMES DE VERGY" *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Pinot Noir
- The Vergy family, one of the most powerful families of Burgundy, dates back to the 12th century
- The Lieu-Dit still bears the name of Alix de Vergy (Duchesse of Burgundy) to this day
- The Vineyards are located on south facing slopes in Meuilley, in the hills above Nuits-Saint-George
- The soils are limestone and rock with some clay
- Wines are aged for 12 months in French oak barrels
- Elegant, delicious and well-crafted with a creamy texture, this wine is ready for drinking now or can be kept for up to 5 years.



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON CORTON-CHARLEMAGNE GRAND CRU *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Chardonnay
- The Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru vineyards straddle the communes of Pernand Vergelesses and Aloxe-Corton and enjoy a south westerly exposure; The soil is white marl and almost pure limestone
- Corton-Charlemagne was planted at the request of Emperor Charlemagne's wife who could no longer stand seeing his beard so stained by drinking red Corton
- Wines are aged in 50% new French oak barrels for 18 months
- Magnificently concentrated, a very fine nose with aromas of acacias, honeysuckle blossoms and nuts
- Very pure and powerful with superb depth that will age up to 10 years



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON PULIGNY-MONTRACHET, LES PUELLES 1ER CRU *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Chardonnay
- Les Pucelles is one of the best known and most famous of Puligny's 1er Crus, just adjacent to the Grand Crus of Batard and Bienvenue Batard Montrachet
- The soils are a complex mix of mineral clay and limestone rock
- Guyon produces only three barrels (75 cs) from this tiny parcel
- The wine is aged for 15 months in French oak barrels
- Ethereal aromas of pear, apple, lime and mixed with notes of mushroom and earth; elements of honeysuckle and herbs; The finish is cool, precise, focused and very long.



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DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON MEURSAULT-CHARMES, LES CHARMES DESSUS 1ER CRU *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Chardonnay
- The Guyon Les Charmes Dessus is the upper part of the Les Charmes 1er Cru, high on the slopes just below 1er Cru Perrieres
- Meursault lies in the southern part of the Côte de Beaune, where an eastern exposure ensures maximum sunlight during the days
- Soils are predominantly white marl limestone.
- The wine is aged for 15 months in French oak barrels, (30% new)
- Aromas of honey and very rich in the mouth, with hints of almond; Excellent depth, focus and precision
- This wine can be enjoyed now, or aged for up to 10 years



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON PERNAND-VERGELESSES, SOUS FRÊTILLE 1ER CRU *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Chardonnay
- Pernand-Vergelesse is located northwest of Beaune; The very steep slopes there enjoy good south-easterly exposure and white marl soils, predominantly limestone.
- The 1er Cru Sous Frétille is at the top of the Corton hill, just above the Grand Cru Corton Charlemagne itself
- Sous-Frétille refers to the proximity of this climat close to the forest trees atop the hillside; It means "under the fluttering leaves"
- The wine is aged for 15 months in French oak barrels
- Flowery aromas and hints of hazelnuts; An elegant wine with a lot of finesse and freshness



DOMAINE ANTONIN GUYON BOURGOGNE CHARDONNAY *Burgundy, France*

- 100% Chardonnay
- The Bourgogne Chardonnay vineyard covers one acre on south facing slopes that are well-known for the quality of its wines
- Bourgogne Blanc is produced from a small 1 acre plot located in the heart of the Hautes Côtes de Nuits Dame de Vergy vineyard
- Grapes are hand harvested, then carried in small boxes and sorted out upon arrival at the winery
- Ageing in oak barrels and estate bottled after 12 months
- Very refreshing fruit is supported by good acidity; This is an easy-to drink wine with a good structure



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
