- 100% Muller-Thurgau
- Notes of green apple and blackcurrant
- Balanced freshness with a touch of minerality
- Pairs well with fish, shellfish, chicken and other light fare

**DURBACHER SCHLOSS STAUFENBERG** KLINGELBERGER (RIESLING) VDP ORTSWEIN 2015 Baden (Ortenau), Germany

- 100% Riesling
- Light yellow color with notes of apples and pears
- · Crisp and citrusy, delicate and elegant
- Pairs well with raw fish as well as Asian cuisine, chicken, salmon or tuna



#### MARKGRAF VON BADEN

**DURBACHER SCHLOSSBERG KLINGELBERGER** (RIESLING) 1782 VDP ERSTE LAGE 2015 Baden (Ortenau), Germany

- 100% Riesling
- Bright golden yellow. Notes of ripe peaches, lime and pear
- Complex and powerful
- Pairs well with poultry, salads and hard cheeses



## MARKGRAF VON BADEN BERMATINGER PINOT NOIR **VDP ORTSWEIN 2013/2014** Baden (Lake Constance), Germany

- 100% Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir)
- Ruby red with red current aromas. Tannins are smooth and structured with depth and fruit flavors on the pallet
- Excellent with cheese and charcuterie platters, ham, pork, poultry, and barbecued meats



# **MARKGRAF VON BADEN GAILINGER SCHLOSS RHEINBURG** PINOT NOIR VDP ERSTE LAGE 2011

- Baden (Lake Constance), Germany 100% Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir)
- Rich ruby red. Fruity and spicy on the nose with a hint of vanilla
- On the palate powerful with subtle hints of fruit and spices
- · Excellent with red meats and cheeses

DURBACHER SCHLOSSBERG "SOPHIENBERG" PINOT NOIR VDP GROSSE LAGE 2014

Baden (Ortenau), Germany

- 100% Spätburgunder (Pinot Noir)
- Hand-picked grapes, destemmed and soft crushed
- Aged 24 months in French barrels
- Nice fruity flavors that recall Burgundy notes
