BACKGROUND

Jean-Claude Mas, independent winemaker, fourth generation grape grower, first generation winemaker and owner of Domaines Paul Mas, is a leader in fine winemaking in the Languedoc region of the South of France. Since taking the helm of the family winery in 2000, he has prioritized sourcing the highest quality grapes from twelve privately owned estates and premier growers in the Languedoc to make wines of authenticity and refinement. The result is a collection of magnificently charming wines that burst forward with the warmth and stunning beauty of the Languedoc.

Named after the original Mas family home, Château Paul Mas and Paul Mas Estate wines showcase the terroir, complexity and style of Languedoc estate superior winemaking.

APPELLATION

Languedoc (Côteaux du Languedoc), France

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

85% Syrah, 10% Grenache, 5% Mourvèdre

WINEMAKING & VINTAGE NOTES

The Syrah vines are between 25- and 35-year old, the Grenache 30-year old and the Mourvèdre 18-year old. The soil type is clay and limestone with fossils and limestone rocks.

AGEING

The wine is aged for nine months in French oak barrels (Seguin Moreau, François Frères) and American (Seguin Moreau). 30% new oak barrels, 35% one-year-old oak barrels, 35% two-year-old oak barrel.

TASTING NOTES

Amethyst color. Nose is complex with blackcurrants, violet, blackberries, turning to cacao and spices. A full bodied wine. Aromas of peanut butter, cocoa, and dried berries with a silky, dry-yet-fruity medium body and a tangy, dark berry tart, apple sauce, cedar, and mineral nuanced finish with chewy tannins.

Pairs well with beef, lamb, or game meats, as well as strong cheeses.
