




Riesling "Cuvée Frédéric Émile"



Frédéric Émile Trimbach

- Produced since 1967, Cuvée Frédéric Émile comes from two single vineyard Grand Cru sites: Geisberg and Osterberg, located just behind the Trimbach winery in Ribeauvillé. This legendary Riesling is named for Trimbach ancestor, Frédéric Émile Trimbach, whose son, Frédéric Théodore, transferred the Trimbach firm to the medieval town of Ribeauvillé soon after World War I. He was one of the founders of the wine-growers and merchants' association and one of the first promoters of Alsace wine. As an outstanding taster, his judgment was sought after in the whole Alsace wine growing area.

- Cuvée Frédéric Émile -- an equal blend of Geisberg and Osterberg Grands Crus -- is made exclusively from very ripe grapes, selectively hand picked at the end of the harvest.
- Full-bodied, firmly-structured and long-lived, the wine has extraordinary balance between fruit and acidity with intense minerality and superb length. The concentrated fruity aromas include nectarine, apricot, pineapple, and candied peaches.
- The wine is stainless steel fermented (not oak-aged), and is vinified to complete dryness (with only the minimal amount of RS). Bottling is done early to preserve freshness, and the wine rests in bottle in the cellar for several years before reaching the marketplace, ensuring the wine is both ready to drink upon release but also can be cellared for 20+ years.
- It is the only Alsace wine listed on all 28 of France's three-star Michelin restaurants.
- Pierre Trimbach (winemaker since 1979) was named one of the world's Top Ten White Winemaker by Decanter Magazine in 2006 and "Wine Personality of 2016" by Bethane & Desseauve Magazine and they scored CFE 2008 a rare 20/20 or 100 points.
