### BACKGROUND

Noble Tree was originally founded as a passion project by two sommeliers/restaurateurs to produce wines for their fellow industry friends. Production began as a true “garagistes-négociant” style winery, focusing on healthy vineyard sources, hand-harvesting and honest winemaking practices. In 2019, Marc D. Taub of Taub Family Vineyards became proprietor of Noble Tree, upholding the mission and essence of the winemaking philosophy: to respect the varietal character and reflect the vineyard site and vintage conditions in each wine.

### APPELLATION

Sonoma County (Russian River Valley), California

### VARIETAL COMPOSITION

100% Grenache

### WINEMAKING & VINTAGE NOTES

The Starr Ridge Vineyard is north of the transition where the Russian River turns west toward the Pacific Ocean. It has a more diffused nature to the fog and reaches temperatures a couple of degrees above the average Sonoma Coast vineyard most days. It's a very slight difference but added up over the 240-day growing season, it adds concentration to the wine.

### AGEING

Aged for ten months in French oak.

### TASTING NOTES

Concentrated aromas of cherry, raspberry, and earthy notes. The luscious mid palate is rich with dark red fruit flavors and baking spice, with a balanced acidity.




