



The Facts

- Established in 1626, the Trimbach family is on their 13th generation of ownership.
- Vineyards are planted on the Ribeauvillé’s faultline that fractured 50M years ago between the Vosges Mountain range and the Black Forest. This offers a mosaic of terroirs including complex calcareous limestone and bio-degraded seashell fossils called “Muschelkalk”.
- In 1972, Maison Trimbach eradicated all chemical use from the vineyard and winery and has been practicing sustainable agriculture for the Classic range and organic production for the Reserves, Gold labels, Grands Crus, and Prestige wines. In 1996, Maison Trimbach was the first to introduce sexual confusion capsules as a sustainable measure in Alsace. Additionally, harvests are carefully performed only by hand.
- The Trimbach style is characterized by producing the finest dry and balanced wines with no malolactic fermentation and no new oak ageing- a style that can last graciously for years. The wines pair with ALL cuisines of the world because of their fruitiness, freshness, dryness, purity and sumptuous balance.
- A “Grand House” among small producer houses which typically average only 7.5 acres, the Trimbach family now owns over 136 acres of AOP classified vineyards.
- Trimbach has been the #1 Alsace producer in cases sold in the US since 1978; however, it is NOT the largest house! Maison Trimbach’s production is under 100,000cs/year.
- While Grands Crus in Alsace represents 4% of total production, Trimbach’s Grands Crus represent 30% of their own production.
- While the Riesling varietal represents around 22% of Alsace’s total production it represents over 40% of Trimbach’s own production. Riesling is King!
- Produced since 1919, Clos Ste. Hune is a Monopole–wholly-owned parcel–of just over 4 acres, with fewer than 8,000 btls/year, in the Grand Cru Rosacker. The wine is described by many International press members as “the DRC of Alsace.”
- Produced since 1967, the legendary Cuvée Frédéric Émile is an equal blend of Geisberg and Osterberg Grands Crus. It is the only Alsace wine listed on 26 of France’s three-star Michelin restaurants.
- Clos Ste. Hune and Cuvée Frédéric Émile are sought-after wines to collect and/or cellar evidenced by their ranking #1 & #3 respectively with the highest amount of searches on Wine Searcher.com in 2017.
- Pierre Trimbach, winemaker since 1979, was named one of the world’s Top Ten White Winemakers by Decanter Magazine in 2006. Pierre was also named “Wine Personality of 2016” by Bettane & Desseauve French Wine Guide and they scored Cuvée Frédéric Émile 2008 a rare 20/20.
- Pierre Trimbach has also been the president of the “Vendanges Tardives and Sélection de Grains Nobles” (Late Harvest and SGN) committee since 2000.
- Alsace has enjoyed ten very good to exceptional vintages in the last 10 years. A record of top vintages!
