A wine with dried violets, burnt blackberry essence, charcoal, treacle, resin and baking spices. Full body, very chewy tannins and a long, very decadent finish. Best in a long time. It needs time though. Drink in 2023. - J.S.

**POINTS** Wine Spectator DECEMBER 2019

The core of black cherry, blackberry, black current and violet flavors is shaded by vanilla and toasty oak notes. Balanced and refined, with a light layer of dusty tannins on the finish... Drink now through 2028. - B.S.

**POINTS** JANUARY 2019

...Offers loads of succulent softness with medium to full-bodied structure to hold it all together... Dark fruit is followed by grilled rosemary and scorched earth. The warm vintage is nicely expressed here. This is a good value. - M.L.

**POINTS** VINOUS **JUNE 2020** 

...Sweet violets and hints of tobacco blow off to reveal depths of crushed blackberry and cherry with a dusting of confectioner's spice... Silky textures usher in cool-toned red and blue fruits, further accentuated by cooling minerality, as youthful tannins build. The finish is long and structured, displaying grippy tannins... - E.G.
