...Broad and fleshy on the palate, offering deeply pitched black and blue fruit, black cardamom, candied violet, olive and bitter chocolate flavors that become sweeter as the wine opens up. Youthfully chewy tannins add grip to a very long, smoky finish that echoes the black fruit, licorice and spice notes. —J.R.

OCTOBER 2021

The flagship wine of this producer, this velveteen Syrah matured 18 months in 100% new French oak. Crème de cassis and blueberry compote on the palate are shaded by streaks of allspice, smoke and licorice candy. Opulent and silky in profile, the wine shows well already but will meld and gain subtlety through 2035 at least. —A.I.

Featuring typical la Landonne scents of mocha and roasted meat, the 2018 Cote Rotie la Landonne also boasts plenty of cherry-berry fruit. Medium to full-bodied, it's richly concentrated and velvety on the palate, adding notes of vanilla on the long, silky finish. —J.C.
