



Riesling Grand Cru Schlossberg

- In 2012, the Trimbach Family purchased 5 acres of the well reputed Grand Cru Schlossberg. The first vintage produced was in 2014 -- an excellent vintage for pure and crystalline Rieslings. This was the beginning of a collection of Grands Crus Rieslings at Trimbach, next to their other jewels -- Frédéric Émile and Clos Ste Hune.
- Grand Cru Schlossberg has a granitic terroir composed of granite from Thannenkirch above Ribeauvillé and granite migmatite from Kaysersberg. Planted in horizontal terraces, south facing, located next to the castle at the base of a forest, the vineyard benefits from a cooler microcosm. This Riesling is delicate, dry, precise and able to age for at least 10 years.
- Only 4,000 bottles (avg.) of this limited production Grand Cru Schlossberg are produced.
