POINTS OCTOBER 2015

Impressively precise and elegant nose displaying ripe and seductive pineapple aromas. Full-bodied, round and complex on the palate this is intensely fruity, almost lush and slightly sweet, with a persistent mineral structure and a lingering salinity. An impressive wine... – S.R.

Beautifully aromatic and inviting, with its petrol and flint notes, as well as flavors of nectarine, fleur de sel and candied Meyer lemon zest, this is lightly fleshy in texture, with vibrant acidity keeping this focused and staying well-defined through to the well-spiced finish. - A.N.

POINTS vinous JANUARY 2019

Enters juicy and bright, then turns more austere; a noteworthy vertical acid spine... lifts and extends the tropical and stone fruit flavors. Finishes long and tactile, with slightly chewy mouthfeel and a repeating note of underbrush and mushrooms. – I.D.

POINTS Wine Spirits **APRIL 2018**

Exotic scents of ripe peach and Kaffir lime introduce this rich wine, its savory fruit-skin structure firm enough to channel the sweetness and focus the botrytis scents on ginger and orange rind. It's cloaked with heavily botrytis, needing a cheese plate to show its best. - T.T
