






"RÉSERVE PERSONNELLE" PINOT GRIS 2011

Beautifully balanced, this rich white features a finely knit, elegant frame, with racy acidity and abundant smokelaced minerally character, supporting the flavors of glazed nectarine, pine forest, chamomile, sliced almond and lemon curd. Offers a long, aromatic finish. – A.N.



Truffled foie gras in the glass mingles with... peach and citrus in antici-pation of precisely the mingling of decadent rich-ness and lusciously bright fruit that follows on a firm but polished palate. Juicy pear and subtly smoky, bitter-sweet nut oils add allure to a long, interactively complex finish. – D.S.



A deep cinnamon note complements delicate aromas of candied apple and flowers. Quite large-scaled pinot gris, in fact almost a blockbuster by Trimbach standards. Finishes very long and pretty.
