Château Greysac, located in the Médoc hamlet of Begadan, north of St. Estephe, was built in the 1700's. For many years, the property belonged to the late Baron Francois de Günzburg. Jean Guyon, owner of Domaines Rollan de By, purchased the estate in 2012 and has brought the property to its prime. His dedication to the estate and its wines have fostered the continued success of Château Greysac – now with over 60 years distribution in the U.S.

Today, the château's characteristic style is one of great aromatic finesse, combined with precise, sumptuous fruit flavors that develop in elegance and complexity over time.

- Château Greysac is the #1 Médoc Bordeaux \$20+ in Nielsen. (AOC+ Liquor 52 Weeks, Bordeaux 750ml 10/12/23). The estate has garnered 90+ ratings on the Médoc since 2012 when Jean Guyon took over.
- The 2018 vintage of the Médoc is now a Cru Bourgeois Supérieur and the 2022 vintage of the Sauvignon Blanc is estate-bottled (on back label)!
- Jean Guyon, proprietor of Château Greysac purchased the estate in 2012, becoming the largest land-owner in Médoc creating optimal, sustainable vineyard management and consistent high quality. Since 2018, the winery has been HVE3 certified.

Located in the northern part of Médoc, not far from the Atlantic Ocean and close to the Estuary of the Gironde, the estate is a 180-hectare vineyard that benefits from a microclimate, protected from extreme conditions.

The vines are 70% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot and 5% Cabernet Franc planted on gravelly soil known as the Gunzian gravel, combined with sand and clay sub-layers.

In 2020 the Classification of the Cru Bourgeois du Médoc was published and includes 250 Chateaux. The Cru Bourgeois has three categories:

- Cru Bourgeois
- Cru Bourgeois Supérieur
- Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel

Chateau Greysac's 2018 vintage was classified as Supérieur

Quality Procedure:

- All wines are blind tasted
- Classification is applicable for 5 years

- Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot
- The chateau's characteristic style is one of great aromatic finesse, combined with precise, sumptuous fruit flavors that develop in elegance and complexity over time
- Deep ruby garnet with red berry flavors combined with background notes of spice and bell pepper
- Aged for 12 months (50% in one year old French oak barrels and 50% in tanks)
- An elegant expression with ample plums and berries on the nose and palate, accented by a floral note
- Pairs with all meats, poultry, wild mushrooms and strong cheeses

- 100% Sauvignon Blanc
- Le Blanc de Greysac is the special project of proprietor, Jean Guyon; Jean's goal is to produce the perfect complement to Château Greysac Médoc, Le Blanc de Greysac embodies that spirit
- Vines (average 15 years old) are from carefully selected parcels of clay-limestone soils
- The gold mesmerizing color of its label is a reminder of the brightness of this Sauvignon Blanc gem
- Perfectly balanced aromatic and vibrant style; Citrus, green apple, and mineral notes
- This will complement seafood, salads, fresh grilled fish, lobster rolls and white meats with delicacy



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
