BACKGROUND

Château Greysac, located in the Médoc hamlet of Begadan, north of St. Estephe, was built in the 1700's. For many years, the property belonged to the late Baron Francois de Gunzburg. In 1975, the property was sold to the Agnelli family, which transformed the estate and its winemaking capabilities significantly. Château Greysac was purchased by Jean Guyon, owner of Domaine Rollan de By, in 2012, joining their exciting portfolio of Bordeaux wines.

Today, the chateau's characteristic style is one of great aromatic finesse, combined with precise, sumptuous fruit flavors that develop in elegance and complexity over time.

Château Greysac Le Blanc is the special project of proprietor, Jean Guyon. Jean's goal is to produce the perfect compliment to Château Greysac rouge, Greysac Blanc embodies that spirit.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

80% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Sauvignon Gris

WINEMAKING & VINTAGE NOTES

Clay-limestone soil. Intra-pellicular maceration, fermentation and lies stirring exclusively in oak barrels for six months.

TASTING NOTES

The gold mesmerizing color of its label is a reminder of the brightness of this predominantly sauvignon blanc gem. Perfectly balanced between seducing peach and apricot flavors, subtle hints of violet and a comforting coat of oak, altogether carried by a refreshing aquiline acidity.

Le Blanc de Greysac will delight and refresh your evenings and complement your seafood, fish and white meats with delicacy.

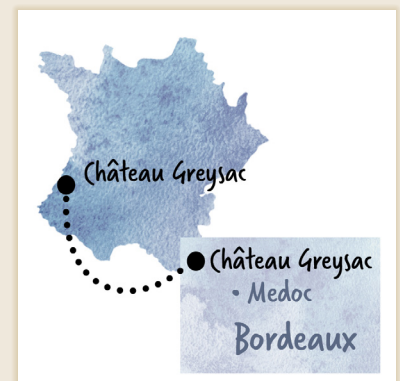
