CORNAS "LA LOUVÉE" 2004

Rhône Valley, France

**POINTS** Wine Spectator JUNE 2007

Has an impressive core of raspberry ganache and dark coffee, with plenty of tobacco, olive, tar and fig notes. The long, muscular finish has excellent grip. – J.M.

**POINTS WINE ENTHUSIAST APRIL 2007** 

Strongly ferrous and minerally, with blackberry and blueberry fruit... This is rich, concentrated and meaty, yet creamy, with supple tannins. Very flattering, with a long finish. This should age well. – J.C.

**POINTS** vinous JANUARY 2007

Rich and expressive on the nose, with deep plum and cassis scents underscored by a rich, chocolatey tone. Fullbodied, chewy and lush, with ripe dark fruit flavors. Finishes with a flavor of sweet, super-ripe creme de cassis and excellent length. - J.R.

**POINTS APRII 2007** 

...Plenty of crushed rocks, mint, cassis as well as truffle and pain grille notes... Dense ruby/purple with notes of minerals, mint (or is it bay leaf?), and plenty of black currants and cherries, the wine is medium to full-bodied and powerful. – R.P.
