## CORNAS "LES RUCHETS" 2010

Rhône Valley, France



Shows a lovely savory hint, with green olive and tobacco notes wrapping around serious chalky grip. The core of butter, cherry, red currant and blackberry fruit sits in the background for now... Driven by minerality, and should age wonderfully as the fruit comes forward... – J.M. Blackberry preserves and cherry-cola on the deeply scented nose and in the mouth... showing impressive concentration and a slow-building floral pastille quality. Becomes spicier with air and shows excellent clarity and focus. Dusty tannins give grip to the finish, which strongly echoes the blackberry note. – J.R.

More finely detailed aromas — violets and cracked pepper accent dark fruit... A full-bodied, dense expression of Cornas, with bright acids high-lighting plum and black olive notes... – J.C.
