Spicy kirsch and blackberry on the nose, with a vibrant cracked pepper quality building in the glass. Very fresh, energetic dark fruit flavors lead to a soft, supple finish featuring silky tannins. Unusually elegant for Cornas, and packed with sweet, velvety fruit. - J.R.
