This is a rock-solid, textbook Cornas, with lots of crushed plum, currant, olive and tobacco notes backed by slightly burly but integrated tannins. The long finish is filled with chalk and olive. — J.M.

Spicy black raspberry and cherry scents are complemented by fresh flowers and minerals. Graceful, finely etched dark berry flavors show surprising depth and power but no excess fat. Supple tannins add grip to the long, juicy finish. — J.R.
