This is strong, with an impressive core of melted black licorice, dark plum, currant and maduro tobacco all laced together with a dark, loamy note. There's a polished mouthfeel, but also brooding intensity. — J.M.

Peppery redcurrant and cherry aromas are complemented by baking spices and clove. Brisk and focused, with tangy red berry flavors, gentle tannins and good mineral snap. Nervy for a Cornas, with very good finishing grip and clarity. - J.R.
